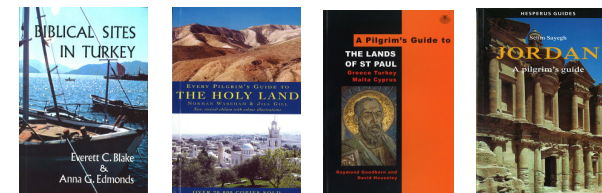

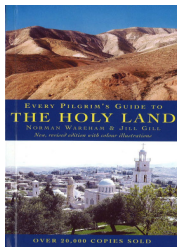

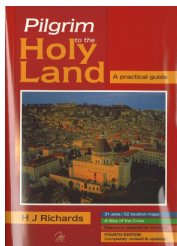
## THE HOLY LAND

Norman and Jill have led many pilgrimages to the Holy Land with McCabe. This pocket-size companion covers all the principal sites and includes Bible references.

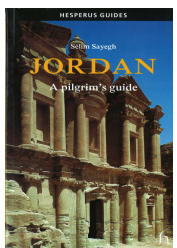
**Pilgrim to the Holy Land** £9.50

## JORDAN

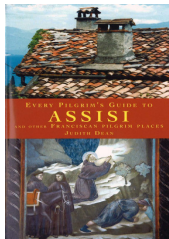
**Jordan - A Pilgrim's Guide** £7.99

## ITALY

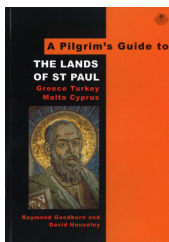
**Pilgrim's Guide to Assisi** £8.99

We have selected one guide written specifically for pilgrim parties visiting Rome and Assisi. Judith Dean's book tells you all you need to know about St Francis and Assisi.

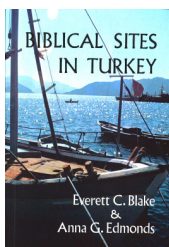
## THE JOURNEYS OF ST PAUL THROUGH GREECE & TURKEY

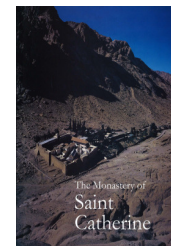
**Biblical Sites in Turkey** £7.95
