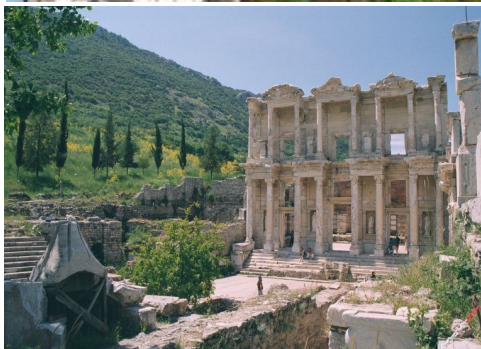

# ISTANBUL AND THE SEVEN CHURCHES OF ASIA

With the Revds Michael & Doreen White

29th April - 9th May 2010

Our eleven-day journey takes us to the ancient land of Turkey which lies at the heart of the New Testament church. The origins of Christianity lie in the ruins of the churches, which generated the growth of our faith westwards from Asia into Europe. Our understanding of the early Christian communities is deepened at places such as Ephesus, Miletus and Laodicea and the lives of St Paul and St John become interwoven. The people, the sites and the geography give us an insight into the world of the first century church.

Our holiday has three distinct parts. We begin with three days in Istanbul, one of the great cities of the world, with a culture and geography that looks both east and west. We then have some long drives in the countryside visiting the ruins of the seven churches of Revelation. Our final three days are based at a resort hotel by the Aegean Sea, a comfortable and relaxing end to our odyssey.



This is the original McCabe Pauline journey through Turkey, refined and improved upon through the years. A programme recommended as the ideal first pilgrimage to New Testament Turkey including the "essential" elements of Istanbul and the Seven Churches of Asia.



## TOUR INFORMATION

The cost of this 11-day tour is £1,295 per person sharing a twin-bedded room with private facilities. We will stay in four hotels all of which are locally graded four stars. Three nights in Istanbul at the Seres Hotel are followed by two nights at the Anemon Hotel in Izmir and an overnight at the Richmond Hotel in Pamukkale. The final four nights are at a large resort style hotel, on the coast, with pool, near Kusadasi. Breakfast and dinner at each hotel are included daily in the tour price [plus seven lunches](#) at various restaurants en route as we follow our programme of visits. Some days (particularly in the middle of the tour) are long and it is good to have a pre-arranged lunch built in to the programme. We will be accompanied on our journey by a local tour guide who will pay all entrance fees on our behalf. We fly on scheduled flights of Turkish Airlines from Heathrow Airport to Istanbul and then from Istanbul to Izmir for the second part of our holiday. We return from Izmir to Heathrow via Istanbul. All flights, airport and security taxes are included in the tour cost.

The only extra that will be added to your invoice is the insurance premium of £29 (if required). We also recommend an amount of £40 for gratuities, to be collected by your tour leader on arrival in Turkey. There is a visa fee of £10 (cash), payable on arrival at Istanbul airport.

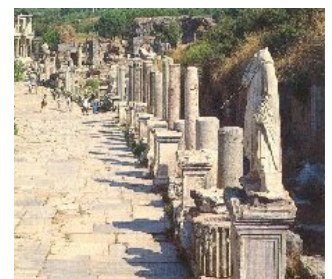
Some single rooms are available and the charge is £195. Please, however, see the note 'Travelling Alone' printed overleaf. Any special requests should be printed on the booking form. A deposit is payable now with the balance payable 8 weeks prior to departure. Full flight and accommodation details will be sent out with your travel wallets 2 weeks before departure.

# DAILY PROGRAMME

## Thursday (29th April) TO TURKEY

We fly from London Heathrow Terminal Three to Istanbul. Our Turkish Airlines flight TK 1980 departs Heathrow at 1125 hours and arrives into Istanbul at 1710 hours. **On arrival we transfer to the Istanbul Seres Hotel (or similar) for a three-night stay.**

## Friday CHRISTIANITY AND ISLAM



We begin in the Hippodrome area of central Istanbul where we visit the architecturally magnificent Blue Mosque and Hagia Sophia. Once a Basilica, then a mosque and now a museum, the 'Divine Wisdom' has a history dating back to the fourth century. We also call at the nearby underground Justinian Cisterns. **Lunch and afternoon exploring Topkapi Palace – residence of the Ottoman sultans for almost three centuries. For those interested, a visit to the nearby Archaeological Museum can be arranged.**

## Saturday BOSPHORUS CRUISE

We begin our day in the Egyptian Spice Market. We then drive to the Byzantine Church (now a museum) of St Saviour in Chora with its stunning mosaics and frescoes. We continue to the harbour of Tarabaya where we **lunch in the Mer fish restaurant.** We sail on the Bosphorus, which is the ideal way to appreciate the grandeur and beauty of this historic city. In the late afternoon we explore the colourful labyrinth of the Grand Bazaar, the oldest covered market in the world.

## Sunday FLY TO IZMIR



In the morning we worship at the Anglican Christ Church (Crimea Memorial Church) in Istanbul.

In the afternoon we fly south to Izmir. Flight TK 326 departs at 1445 and arrives in Izmir at 1545.

**Lunch in the Kalehan Hotel in Izmir.**

## Monday PERGAMUM & THYATIRA

This morning we drive north to the modern-day town of Bergama. Here we visit the great Hellenistic city of **Pergamum** which has a spectacular acropolis situated 1,000 feet above the town. We tour the site and visit the grand theatre with seating for nearly 10,000 people, a library restored to its former glory and the medical centre (the Asclepion). **Lunch at the Caravan Restaurant.** Our return journey takes us through the site of ancient **Thyatira.** We return to Izmir (**Smyrna**) where we call at the Church of St Polycarp and, time permitting, Mount Pagos.

## Tuesday SARDIS & PAMUKKALE

We continue our visits to the Seven Churches driving on to **Sardis** where we see the Temple of Artemis, a Roman gymnasium and elaborate mosaics in the synagogue. **We lunch at the Alkent Restaurant near Sardis** before continuing to **Philadelphia** and Pamukkale - with its unique white terraces and warm calcium pools. **Overnight in the Richmond Thermal Hotel in Pamukkale.**

## Wednesday LAODICEA & APHRODISIAS

We visit the extensive necropolis at Hierapolis, then drive to **Laodicea**, a remote spot in beautiful countryside. Our principal visit today is to the Roman City of Aphrodisias, where the stadium is one of the finest still standing. **We lunch close to the site of Aphrodisias at the Anatolia Restaurant and then continue to the Aegean coast and the Richmond Ephesus Resort Hotel, our base for four nights.**



## Thursday PRIENE, DIDYMA & MILETUS

A circular tour of three ancient cities. Priene overlooks the rich farmlands of the Maeander Valley. Today's highlight is a visit to the ancient oracle in the Temple of Apollo at Didyma. **After lunch in the Kamaci Restaurant** we visit the Port of Miletus where much remains intact including the Lion Harbour and theatre. Here we remember Paul's emotional farewell to the elders of Ephesus.



## Friday EPHESUS

Today we complete our visits to the Seven Churches, visiting **Ephesus.** St Paul lived here for some years and it is one of the most impressive archaeological sites in the world. Much has been reconstructed and it silversmiths in the vast amphitheatre. **Lunch in the Kalehan Hotel in Selcuk.** In the afternoon, we visit the church and burial chamber of St John in Selcuk, and the traditional House of the Virgin Mary, one of the few sites where we are welcome to celebrate a group Eucharist.



## Saturday A DAY AT LEISURE

A day at leisure on the beach or by the pool or your guide will suggest an excursion into the surrounding countryside, perhaps to the pretty hill-side town of Siringe. The nearby resort town of Kus adasi has an interesting harbour overlooked by a fortress with many shops selling carpets and other local handicrafts.

Lunch is not included today.

## Sunday (9th May) HOMEWARD BOUND

An early start as we drive to Izmir airport for Turkish Airlines flight TK 313 which departs at 1000 arriving Istanbul at 1105. Our connecting flight TK 1991 departs Istanbul at 1315 arriving back at Heathrow Airport at 1515 hours.



# TRAVEL TO TURKEY

## TRAVELLING ALONE

Many of our passengers travel alone and object to expensive single room supplements. McCabe Pilgrimages will accept individual bookings on a 'guaranteed share' basis. We charge the basic price and accommodate you with a person of the same sex also requesting shared accommodation. If we do not find someone to share with you, you will be accommodated in a single room at only 50% of the usual single room supplement. For single travellers who do require single accommodation this should be requested when booking and, if available, the normal supplement will be payable.

## PASSPORTS, VISAS AND HEALTH

Check that your passport is valid for at least six months beyond the duration of this tour. If you need a new passport apply NOW as there can be considerable backlogs at the passport offices. Visas are required for Turkey for British passport holders, and obtained on arrival at a cost of £10. If you are holding a non-British passport, or require further advice, please consult the McCabe office. No inoculations are required. We do, however, advise you to consult your doctor regarding your own personal requirements.

## TRAVEL INSURANCE

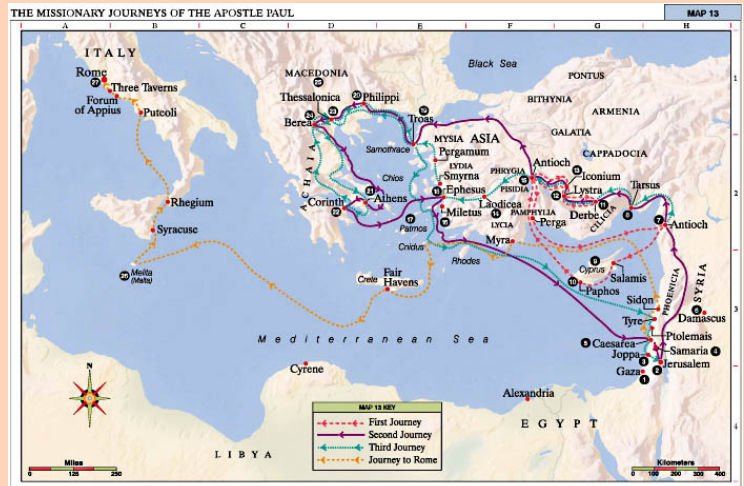
McCabe will arrange comprehensive travel insurance cover for each passenger unless otherwise indicated on the booking form. We have negotiated the premium (see 'Tour Information' section inside for rate) which as well as offering full medical and baggage cover also gives cover against loss of deposits. Cover is arranged by Preferential Insurance Services Ltd and is underwritten by Optimum Underwriting Limited as underwriting agents for Groupama Insurance Company Limited – each aforementioned organisation is authorised and regulated by The Financial Services Authority (FSA). The policy wording sets out full details of cover and will be sent to you with your confirmation invoice. This document also acts as your insurance certificate so that your booking reference number is also your insurance policy number.

A special feature of the McCabe insurance is that there is no age limit. Please, however, note it is a requirement that all insured persons must adhere to the Medical Health Requirements section on page 5 of the Policy wording document (which we will send you with your confirmation invoice). If you answer yes to any of the questions asked within this section you must contact the [HELPLINE 0845 250 5220](tel:08452505220). This is a confidential service that will decide whether or not this insurance is appropriate for you. If they decline to offer cover, or if you are unhappy with any aspect of the cover, you can return the policy within 14 days of issue and receive a full refund. In cases of difficulty, we have specialist insurers we can introduce you to.
